In worship this past Sunday we continued our summer sermon series by looking at the deadly sin of wrath. We looked at how anger in itself isn't a sin but if it isn't handled properly it can quickly lead us there. In Ephesians 6:26 Paul writes, *'in your anger do not sin'*. That's great advice and the primary sin that we need to look out for is wrath. Wrath is mishandled anger. Its anger unleashed and spilled on the people around us. Its anger lived out and expressed in harmful ways.

In this same passage, Paul goes on to say, *"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."* That's good advice too isn't it?

Paul is reminding us here that when our tempers flare we should really watch what comes out of our mouths. Remember the old saying, *"Sticks and stones may break my bones, but words can never hurt me."* It's just not true. Words can hurt. They have power. God created the world using words but our words can also do incredible damage.

Remember anger in itself isn't sinful but it is an emotion that we need to handle with care so that it doesn't turn into sin. If anger is a problem in your life and it seems to be damaging your relationships, I encourage you to spend some time talking to God about it. Ask Him to help you guard your heart and your words so that your anger doesn't lead you down a path that you'd prefer not to travel down. At the end of the day, He is the only thing that can *untangle* us from the deadly sin of wrath.
